Noida: Uttar Pradesh Technical University has signed an MoU with the National Institute for Entrepreneurship and Small Business Development (NIESBUD) to impart entrepreneurship skills among its students.

NIESBUD is a premier organization under ministry of micro, small and medium enterprises engaged in training, consultancy and research, to promote entrepreneurship.

Arun Kumar Jha, director general of NIESBUD, said the institute will help UPTU and its affiliated colleges in carrying out training and entrepreneurship development programmes. The NIESBUD team will start a faculty development programme from January.

"The idea is to develop a culture of entrepreneur-ship in these academic insti-

tutions. We will provide information and technological support to college teachers by organizing a research and documentation programme,"

"We will teach students that it is more important to develop an 'idea' than thinking of 'capital'," he added.

UPTU had earlier signed a MoU with IIT Bombay to facilitate access to different important software and spoken tutorial programmes available on open platforms.

On Friday, the University formed a seven-member team to start the faculty development programme to implement the 'spoken tutorial' programme.

Dr R K Khandal, UPTU vice-chancellor, said the University will soon offer an M Tech programme in Design and Technology at its Noida campus from the 2015 academic session.
